About the Stronger Together Network

The Stronger Together Network began as an informal network of organisations who work predominantly with culturally and linguistically diverse communities. The key outcomes of the group were to increase sharing of information and identification of partnership opportunities. Nine organisations make up the consortium who currently lead the network: STEP, Chinese Welfare Association, Inter Ethnic Forum, Building Communities Resource Centre, Community Arts Partnership, African & Caribbean Support Organisation Northern Ireland, VPRS **ESOL** Coordination Point, Omagh Ethnic Communities Support Group and North West Migrants Forum.

In 2012, the network successfully applied for funding from the PHA (Public Health Agency) to allow the network to become more formalised and structured. There are currently over 250 members representing BME organisations and groups, individuals, community sector, volunteer sector and public service sector.

The three key outcomes are to:

- 1. Share information and knowledge
- 2. Provide a useful and central shared resource to connect service providers within the sector
- 3. Identify new opportunities for partnership and innovation

Membership of the Stronger Together Network is currently free of charge

We are doing this through a number of *mediums including:*

- The development of a website for service providers which will allow easy access to region specific information upcoming about events, new research, best practice resources and programs, funding opportunities and policy information
- An annual conference providing workshops and presentations on themes specific to the sector
